Episode 15 - Studio Lighting

Stay away from incandescent lighting its too warm.

Too much light in your studio can make your colors chalky or too light.

Fluorescent lighting- Mix warm and cool bulbs, 4 ft long 6500 kelvin (cool) and 4000 kelvin (warm). this gives you a balanced temperature, not too warm or cool.

at least 2 fixtures that hold 2 4 ft bulbs.

Compact fluorescent light (cfl)- fluorescent bulbs, 4000 kelvin and 6500 kelvin used in clamp lights is an alternative to the 4 foot or 2 foot light fixtures
