### New Mexico:

Along I-25 heading north towards Albuquerque, There are a number of small farm villages strung out along the Rio Grande River

Any where in and around Sheridan Wy and Buffalo Wy. Take Highway 14 into the Big Horn Mountains. Subtle views of mountains and rolling hills with ranches and great cottonwoods.

Rural Illinois, near Chicago

Idaho, near Sun Valley

Mountains in Flagstaff. There are a lot of easy, accessible trails.

Patagonia, Arizona. Cotton woods and sycamore groves.
